


Reason for Time-to-Degree




University of Wisconsin Eau Claire Degree Audit/Transcript Analysis


Educational Attainment Dashboard



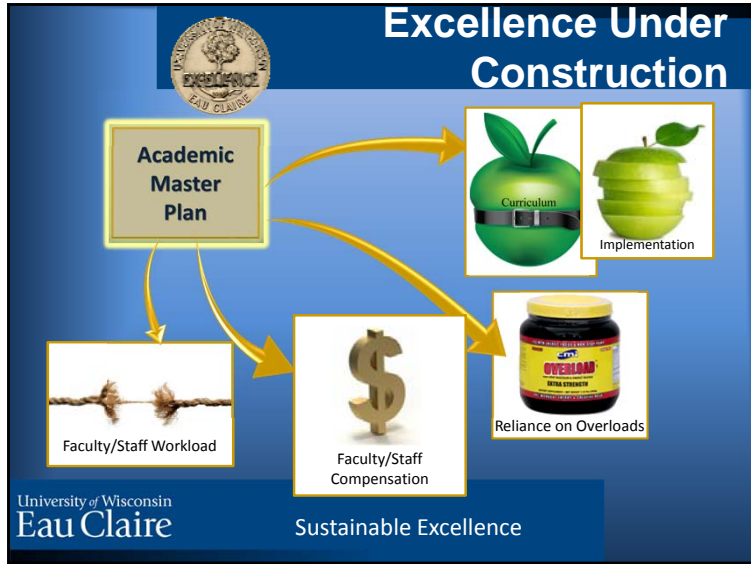
