SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Admitted students are invited to apply for scholarships provided by the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. These scholarships are awarded based on academic achievements, school and community activities, leadership, and the information requested on the scholarship application. Most are not based on financial need.

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES:

- Priority deadline for students starting in **Fall (September)**: April 1
- Application deadline for students starting in **Fall (September)**: June 1
- Application deadline for students starting in **Spring (January)**: December 1

Scholarship applications received after the deadlines will only be considered if additional money becomes available.
