

OUTSTANDING MANAGEMENT STUDENT AWARD

First awarded during the Spring of 2001, this award is presented to an outstanding Management student. This individual is selected by the Management faculty and receives a monetary award certificate.

General Evaluation Emphasis

Evaluation criteria include academic achievement, involvement in student organization activities, activities in College of Business, and commitment to the management profession. Management faculty can nominate up to three students for the award and are responsible for obtaining a current resume of the student's accomplishments.

Evaluation Criteria

- Overall GPA of 3.0 and GPA of 3.5 or higher in the Management major (required).
- Regular and sustained service to student organizations through the holding of various positions or accomplishing specific responsibilities for the organization.
- Participating in activities that have enhanced the stature, reputation, visibility, and overall strength of the Management major.
- Overall excellence of academic performance, such as coursework, presentations, and scholarly activities with faculty

Overall professional commitment and participation (e.g. internship, passing certification exams, presentation of papers at conferences).
