Before returning the application, please make sure that you:

1. Complete all items related to personal data.
2. Review carefully the criteria for all scholarships.
3.
  - a. Develop and submit a one-page typed narrative identifying and explaining at least three characteristics that will make you a unique teacher. These qualities set you a part from your peers. Please note that essays containing grammatical and mechanical errors will receive lower scores. (Since the Financial Aid Office furnishes financial need information, focus on positive attributes and skills.)
  - b. Attach a resume that specifically identifies activities related to academic accomplishments, experiences related to teaching, and professional involvement and leadership contributions at UW-Eau Claire and in the community. (See sample resume.)
  - c. A minimum of two recommendations must be completed and submitted directly to Linda Brunner (do not include with scholarship application). Ask at least one University faculty member and another professional person familiar with your community and university activities to submit recommendations on your behalf to the Scholarship Committee. The recommendation form must be used and is available as a form field Word document. Additional information may be attached to the form.
4. It is required that scholarship recipients attend the Scholarship Reception on April 22, 2009.

Applications, related materials, and supportive documentation must be submitted to Linda Brunner in the Department of Special Education (HSS 246) by **February 6, 2009 at 4:00 p.m.**

Applications will be awarded on the basis of a) GPA, b) narrative and resumé, c) recommendations, d) financial need as appropriate, and e) additional faculty input.
