Ruth L. Baker Scholarship (\$700)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Education
Full-time student during junior practicum
Resident total grade point average of 3.5 or better
Recommended by the Department of Curriculum & Instruction for a junior practicum experience
**Recommendations must be from faculty in Curriculum & Instruction Department

Faye Davis Berg Teacher's Scholarship (\$800)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate major in Teacher Education Program in preparing to become elementary or secondary teacher
High potential for success as a teacher
Demonstrated outstanding performance in pre-student field experiences
To be awarded during the student teaching semester (Fall 2007 or Spring 2008)
Resident total grade point average of 3.5 or better
**Biographical essay—Future plans and goals

Mae Bertelson Scholarship (\$1,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Education
Have completed or be completing the junior block
Have been recommended by the Department of Curriculum & Instruction for student teaching experience
Full-time student
Resident total grade point average of 3.5 or better
Demonstrated excellent potential as an elementary teacher
To be awarded during the student teaching semester (Fall 2007 or Spring 2008)
**Biographical essay—Future plans and goals

Donald Birr Memorial Scholarship (\$150)

Eligibility Criteria: Have strong academic record
Be admitted to Teacher Education Program
Give evidence of interest in and/or have concentration in middle school preparation

Mildred O. Burcalow Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Education
Strong record of academic achievement

Delta Kappa Gamma (\$200)

Eligibility Criteria: Age 23 or older
Currently enrolled
Good academic standing
Pursuing degree in education

Grace Brown Dole Elementary Education Scholarship (\$300)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Education
Have completed or be completing the junior block
Have been recommended by the Department of Curriculum & Instruction for student teaching experience
Resident total grade point average of 3.0 or better
Demonstrated excellent potential as an elementary teacher
**Biographical essay—Future plans and goals

Eleanor Eddis Fults Memorial Scholarship (\$6,202)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate elementary education major
Completed one year of course work at UW-Eau Claire
Illustrated significant academic quality and significant promise for the teaching profession
Financial need will be considered but need is not the determining factor
**Biographical essay—Future plans and goals

Winnie R. Gibson Scholarship (\$1,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Non-traditional student who is accepted into the Teacher Education Program
**Submit on-page essay stating the need for and importance of the scholarship

Hanke Family Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Teacher Education Program or Social Work (alternates every other year)
Full-time student
Minimum total GPA of 3.0
Current financial need form on file (FAFSA) in Financial Aids
Succeeding generations of the Hanke family are eligible
May be renewable

Howard O. Johnson Secondary Education Scholarship (\$1,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Be admitted to the Teacher Education Program and have junior or senior standing
Exceptional grasp of the academic subjects he/she will teach in secondary education
Scholarship is a strongly preferred basis for the granting of this scholarship
Demonstrated strong communication skills

Victor H., Madeline F., and Karen A. King Scholarship (\$600)

Eligibility Criteria: Student in majoring Special Education
Full-time student (2007-2008)
Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better
Financial need must be demonstrated
Preference will be given to residents from western and northwestern Wisconsin
**Submit a 500-1000 word autobiography with application

Paul and Linda Kuehn Special Education or Communication Disorders Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Must be at least a second semester junior, admitted to the Special Education program, and possess the following characteristics: Exhibits behavior, which indicates that candidate has potential for becoming a highly effective teacher of young children with disabilities and a professional leader for the improvement and expansion of services at the local, state and national level.
Demonstrates potential for becoming a highly effective teacher and professional leader which includes:
a) strong academic skills, b) positive record of volunteerism with person with disabilities, c) positive record of pre-student teaching experiences based on variety, amount and quality reported by teachers and parents, d) leadership and participation in special education student activities, e) enthusiasm for teaching, and f) commitment and ability to employ "effective" intervention practices

Arnold A. and Eleanor D. Lamberg Teacher Education Scholarship (2/\$1,500)

Eligibility Criteria: Be admitted to the Teacher Education Program (Number/amount of awards may vary at discretion of Scholarship Committee)
Have good potential for a career in education
Have financial need

Milton and Lorraine Larson Scholarship (2/\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Teacher Education Program
Cumulative grade point average of 3.0
Have financial need
Preference will be give to an individual who has participated in athletics and who has completed their eligibility

Daisy Longren Scholarship (\$250)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate major in Special Education
Full-time student
Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better
Financial need will be considered
Preference will be given to Wisconsin residents
**Submit a 500-1000 word autobiography with application
Submit **three letters of recommendation

Jodi Mae Mantel Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Senior student in special education
Exhibits exceptional commitment and enthusiasm
Holds high promise for becoming an excellent teacher of learners with disabilities

Marion K. McNamara Scholarship (\$100)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Education
Strong record of academic achievement

Eugene R. McPhee Scholarship (\$1,500)

Eligibility Criteria: Senior in Teacher Education Program (2007-2008)
Total grade point average of 3.0 or better
Participation in community and university services and activities

Axel and Ellen Peterson Memorial Scholarship (\$600)

Eligibility Criteria: Senior in Teacher Education Program (2007-2008)
Total grade point average of 3.0 or better
Participation in community and university services and activities

Rakstis Social Studies Scholarship (\$1,300)

Eligibility Criteria: Broadfield Social Studies major or teaching major in any one of the following areas: Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, or Sociology
Cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or better
Evidence of commitment to the field (active work on projects relating to degree)
Financial need may be considered

Rakstis Teacher Scholarship (\$1,300)

Eligibility Criteria: Senior student in the School of Education (2007-2008)
Cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or better
Evidence of outstanding potential to work with children
Financial need or non-traditional background may be considered

Eligibility Criteria: Awarded during MCEA block
Attained a high level of scholarship
Shows promise for becoming a successful career teacher
GPA of 3.5 or better; full-time student

Patricia Rinaldi (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Education major from a Wisconsin high school
Financial need
Preference to students in business education

Marian Running (\$1,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate minor in library science
GPA of 3.0 or better; Strong academic record
Demonstrated potential for success in library science
Financial need

Lisa Siegenthaler Memorial Scholarship (\$400)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in Special Education
Senior in Teacher Education Program (2007-2008)
Exhibit exceptional commitment and enthusiasm and hold high promise for becoming an excellent teacher of learners with disabilities
**Submit a 500-1000 word autobiography with application
Submit **three letters of recommendation

Cora and Louis Slock Memorial Scholarship (\$1,800)

Eligibility Criteria: Be admitted to the Teacher Education Program
Possess outstanding academic credentials
Financial need may be considered but is not required

Mary Snudden Memorial Scholarship (\$600)

Eligibility Criteria: Full-time student in Teacher Education Program with a resident grade point average of 3.0 or better
Elementary or Elementary/Middle Level Major who has completed or is completing the Junior Block
Have completed or be completing the Category II (Natural Sciences) component of the General Education Requirements
Have been recommended by the Department of Curriculum & Instruction for student teaching experience
Demonstrated excellent potential as an elementary teacher and be interested in environmental education
To be awarded during the student teaching semester (Fall 2005 or Spring 2006)
**Biographical essay—Future plans and goals

Dr. Juanita Sorenson Scholarship (\$6,202)

Eligibility Criteria: Junior, senior or graduate status with acceptance into the Teacher Education Program
Making satisfactory progress toward undergraduate or graduate degree in elementary education (or equivalent degree)
Grade point average of 3.25 or better
Must demonstrate financial need
**Recommendations must be from faculty in the elementary education program or other UWEC Education Departments

Jerry and Jean Strop Excellent Teacher Scholarship (\$3,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Incoming freshmen through senior status
Top academic achievers to a career in elementary or secondary education
First generation in his/her immediate family to have the opportunity to attend a university
Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
**Must give evidence of employment—at least 150 hours of employment, over the prior two-year period

Laura E. Sutherland Memorial Scholarship (\$700)

Eligibility Criteria: UWEC Senior in Teacher Education Program (2005-2006)
Worthy Wisconsin resident
Demonstrated general excellence
Participation in community and university services and activities

F.H. and Gertrude Conway Thompson Scholarship (\$2,200)

Eligibility Criteria: Junior status in 2009-10, renewed for senior year
Planning to enter the education profession
Must have a well-established scholastic record and a commitment to the field of education
Receive the scholarship during his/her junior and senior years
Participation in community and university services and activities

Maxine Marion Otis Trimberger Scholarship (\$800)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate major in Teacher Education Program
Preference will be given to a Library Science minor with a major in Communication Arts, Theatre Arts, or other teaching discipline
Grade point average of 3.0 or better

Jewell and John Walters (\$900)

Eligibility Criteria: Major in education
Demonstrates financial need and/or scholastic achievement
Preference may be given to students who will be student teaching or descendents of the Walters family

Anna M. White Scholarship (\$1,500)

Eligibility Criteria: Junior or senior Elementary Education major
Above average GPA
Must have financial need
Demonstrated commitment to a career in teaching

White Family Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Criteria: Undergraduate education major from Barron, Wisconsin
Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
Must have financial need
Renewable up to three years (must remain in good academic standing & maintain 3.0 GPA)

Sabra J. Yule Memorial Scholarship (2/\$1,000)

Eligibility Criteria: Second-semester freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior standing
Preparing to be a preschool/elementary/middle/secondary teacher in CD, ECSE or LD
Grade point average of 3.0 or better
Financial need may be considered
**Submit a 500-1000 word autobiography with application
Submit **three letters of recommendation
