

# Latest offerings of online undergraduate and graduate courses

EAU CLAIRE —University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Continuing Education/UW-Extension has partnered with [Let Me Learn](#) to offer four online courses for educators this coming spring. The Let Me Learn Process® is a trademarked Advanced Learning System that starts with the Learning Connections Inventory to reveal each learner's interactive learning processes. The each course takes the participant beyond “the numbers” to help them become a stronger, more effective teacher and school leader. Nationally and internationally recognized, Let Me Learn has positively affected over 40,000 students and hundreds of teachers in improving their own academic and professional achievement.

These courses fit directly into the UWEC education program and are conducted from the comfort of one’s home. Participants may take the courses for one undergraduate credit or one graduate credit. Course dates run weekly from January through May. 2012 spring courses are:

- "Empowering Learners in the Classroom: Introducing the Let Me Learn Process Advanced Learning System to Students in the Classroom." (1 credit)
- “Mentoring the Teacher — Professional: Building a Community of Learning.” (1 credit)
- "Empowering Learners in the Classroom: Introducing the Let Me Learn Process Advanced Learning System to Students in the Classroom." (3 graduate credits only)
