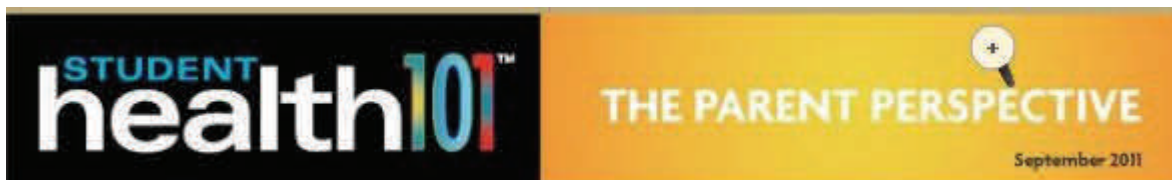

THE MYSTICAL ARTS OF TIBET MANDALA SAND PAINTING

The sacred art of painting with colored sand grains is a Tantric Buddhist tradition involving more than 30 hours of painstaking work. Millions of grains of sand are painstakingly laid into place on a flat platform over a period of days or weeks. The lamas will create *Manjushri Mandala* (Buddha for Wisdom) in Davies Center's Skylight Lounge. Watch the construction of the mandala or join in the creation of a community mandala throughout the week. When the painting is complete there is a closing ceremony during which the monks dismantle the mandala as a metaphor of the impermanence of life.
