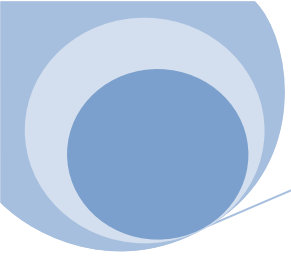


# Childhood Issues: New Baby

- Anholt, Laurence. **Sophie and the New Baby.** (IMC CBC E An498s 2000)  
Sophie waits through the seasons of the year for her sibling to be born and then experiences mixed feelings about the new baby.
- Bunting, Eve. **Twinnies.** (IMC CBC E B8865tw 1997)  
A little girl gradually becomes reconciled to her new twin sisters.
- Carter, Alden. **Big Brother Dustin.** (IMC CBC E C2452b 1997)  
A boy with Down syndrome helps his parents and a grandparent get ready for the birth of his baby sister and chooses the perfect name for her.
- Cole, Joanna. **How You Were Born.** (IMC CBC 612.63 C6752h 1993)  
Text and photos explain how a baby is conceived, how it grows inside the mother's womb, and how it is born.
- Cole, Joanna. **The New Baby at Your House.** (IMC CBC 306.875 C6752n 1998)  
Describes the activities and changes involved in having a new baby in the house and the feelings experienced by the older brothers and sisters.

- Mario, Heidi Stetson. **I'd rather Have an Iguana.** (IMC CBC E M3395i 1999)  
When her mom brings home a new baby, a little girl thinks she would rather have an iguana until she starts to get to know her baby brother.
- McCully, Emily Arnold. **New Baby.** (IMC CBC E M1393n 1988)  
The youngest mouse in a large family discovers excitement and frustration when a new baby arrives.
- Mennen, Ingrid. **One Round Moon and a Star for Me.** (IMC CBC E M5274o 1994)  
A young boy of rural Lesotho needs reassurance that his father is still his papa, too, when a new baby is born into the family.
- Penn, Audrey. **Pocket Full of Kisses.** (IMC CBC E P3805p 2004)  
Chester Raccoon is worried that his mother does not have enough love for both him and his new baby brother.
- Plecas, Jennifer. **Kiki's New Sister.** (IMC CBC E B2753k 1992)  
When Kiki suggests sending her new baby sister back to the hospital, her parents wisely suggest Kiki spend more time helping care for the baby before making a decision.

- Simon, Charnan. **Come! Sit! Speak!** (IMC CBC E Si536c 1997)  
Ariel Kazunas wants a puppy but gets a baby sister instead.
- Titherington, Jeanne. **A Place for Ben.** (IMC CBC E T5346pl 1987)  
When his baby brother is moved into his bedroom, Ben goes elsewhere in search of a place of his own but finds himself longing for company of some kind.
- Vulliamy, Clara. **Ellen and Penguin and the New Baby.** (IMC CBC E V9772e 1996)  
Ellen and her stuffed toy, Penguin, have difficulty adjusting to a new baby brother.
- Zalben, Jane Breskin. **Baby Babka: the Gorgeous Genius.** (IMC CBC E Z144b 2004)  
Unhappy when her baby sister turns out to be a brother, Beryl schemes with her brother Sam to make the newborn disappear, but Uncle Morty helps by telling stories of the love his big sisters had for him, even when he squirted one with pickle juice and ruined another's doll.
