Brooks, Kevin. **Kissing the Rain.** (CBC Fic B7917k 2004)

Fifteen-year-old Moo Nelson, shy, overweight, and bullied by his classmates, finds his life spinning out of control after he witnesses a car chase and a fight that results in a murder.

Caseley, Judith. **Ada Potato.** (CBC E C267a 1989)

Ada stops playing her violin after some older children make fun of her but Mama helps her find a way to handle their teasing.

Edwards, Michelle. **Stinky Stern Forever.** (CBC Fic Ed975s 2005)

Pa Lia and her classmates share memories of Stinky Stern, the second-grade bully.

Fiedler, Julie. **How To Deal With Teasing.** (CBC 158.2 F4527ht 2007)

Garden, Nancy. **Endgame.** (CBC Fic G1674e 2006)

Fifteen-year-old Gray Wilton, bullied at school and ridiculed by an unfeeling father for preferring drums to hunting, goes on a shooting rampage at his high school.

Greene, Constance. **The Ears of Louis.** (CBC Fic G8307e)

A small boy with big ears tries to cope with the teasing and bullying of his classmates.

Johnston, Marianne. **Dealing With Bullying.** (CBC 303.69 J6454b 1996)

Describes what is meant by bullying; then goes on to explain why bullies act as they do, how to deal with them, and how to stop being one.

Kahn, Robert. **Bobby and Mande's Too Smart for Bullies.** (CBC 302.34 K122b 2001)

Kravetz, Jonathan. **How to Deal With Bullies.** (CBC 302.34 K8696h 2007)

Ludwig, Trudy. **Just Kidding.** (CBC Fic L9668j 2006)

With help from his father, older brother, and teacher, D.J. learns how to handle a classmate who claims that his mean-spirited "teasing" is just a joke.

McKay, Hilary. **Indigo's Star.** (CBC Fic M1924i 2004)

Spurred on by his youngest sister, Rose, twelve-year-old Indigo sticks up for himself and an American boy who has replaced him as the primary target of the school bullies.

Meister, Cari. **Luther's Halloween.** (CBC E M47951 2004)

On Halloween, a boy and his pet triceratops named Luther thwart a bully dressed as Dracula who has been taking candy from other trick-or-treaters.

Passen, Lisa. **Fat, Fat Rose Marie.** (CBC E P2667f 1991)

A little girl must stand up to the class bully who keeps picking on her overweight friend.

Pixley, Marcella Fleischman. **Freak** (IMC ON ORDER)

Twelve-year-old Miriam, poetic, smart, and quirky, is considered a freak by the popular girls at her middle school, and she eventually explodes in response to their bullying, revealing an inner strength she did not know she had.

Polacco, Patricia. **Mr. Lincoln's Way.** (CBC Fic P7566m 2001)

When Mr. Lincoln, "the coolest principal in the whole world," discovers that Eugene, the school bully, knows a lot about birds, he uses this interest to help Eugene overcome his intolerance.

Prose, Francine. **Bullyville.** (IMC ON ORDER)

After the death of his estranged father in the World Trade Center on 9/11, thirteen-year-old Bart, still struggling with his feelings of guilt, sorrow and loss, wins a scholarship to the local preparatory school and there encounters a vicious bully whose cruelty compounds the aftermath of the tragedy.

Van Draanen, Wendelin. **Secret Identity.** (CBC Fic V2878s 2004)

Fifth-grader Nolan Byrd, tired of being called names by the class bully, has a secret identity-- Shredderman!

Webster-Doyle, Terrence. **Why Is Everybody Always Picking On Me?** (CBC 303.6 W3996w 1991)

Stories and activities demonstrate how to resolve conflicts nonviolently and how to peacefully confront hostile aggression.
