Inspired by the stories of U.S. military nurses in Vietnam who found that war “followed them home,” this faculty-student research team set out to explore the coming-home experience of today’s nurses returning from Iraq and Afghanistan. Using qualitative methodology, data analysis revealed major stressors of re-entry for the nurses and identified coping strategies they needed while re-adjusting to life and work on the home front.
