- 1 **WHEREAS, United Council of UW Students is an organization that**
- 2 **represents a wide range of student issues at the system, state, and national level;**
- 3 **and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the issues that United Council addresses directly impact and**
- 5 **correlate with all of the Student Senate commissions; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, if the Student Senate Executive Board members were required**
- 7 **to attend a minimum of one General Assembly or Conference per session, they**
- 8 **will be better equipped to address the issues that arise around campus and the**
- 9 **state; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, communication between the commissions and United Council**
- 11 **will greatly increase Student Senate's effectiveness when addressing student**
- 12 **issues; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this will also benefit UW-Eau Claire by keeping more student**
14 **leaders informed and involved with the campaigns around the state; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Executive Board members will also gain in their**
16 **understanding of “how things work” around the UW System and the state; and**

17 **WHEREAS, this will also help UW-Eau Claire be a stronger presence on the**
18 **system and state level; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the addition in “Attachment A” will require Student Senate**
20 **Executive Board members to attend a minimum of one United Council General**
21 **Assembly or Conference per session;**

22 **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the amendment to the Bylaws in**
23 **“Attachment A” take effect immediately; and**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President French transmit**
25 **a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Steve Tallant,**
26 **Provost/Vice Chancellor; Andrew Soll, Vice Chancellor, Business and Student**
27 **Services; Dr. Marty Wood, Chair, University Senate; United Council; Ann Lapp,**
28 **Interim Associate Vice Chancellor, Student Development & Diversity; and Jodi**
29 **Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Student Development, Student Development &**
30 **Diversity.**
