DIRECTOR AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

- 1           **WHEREAS, students at all UW-System schools are required to pay a fee**  
2 **each year to maintain and enhance technology on their campus; and**
- 3           **WHEREAS, this fee (STF) is equal to 2% of the previous year's tuition costs**  
4 **in accordance with UW-System policy; and**
- 5           **WHEREAS, the UW-System guidelines require that the STF be spent on**  
6 **technology which is generally accessible to all students; and**
- 7           **WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission of UW-Eau Claire, in**  
8 **cooperation with the Director of Learning and Technology Services, is charged**  
9 **with making recommendations for the allocation of the STF funds each year; and**
- 10           **WHEREAS, fluctuation in the price of technological equipment force the**  
11 **Information Technology Commission to set budget ranges for each category of**  
12 **the STF; and**

13           **WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission has completed its**  
14 **research and review process for the FY 2009 STF budget ranges;**

15           **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the UW-Eau Claire Student Senate**  
16 **approves the Information Technology Commission’s recommendations for the FY**  
17 **2009 STF budget ranges (Attachment “A”); and**

18           **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President French transmit**  
19 **a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Steve Tallant,**  
20 **Provost/Vice Chancellor; Andrew Soll, Vice Chancellor, Business and Student**  
21 **Services; Dr. Marty Wood, Chair, University Senate; United Council; Ann Lapp,**  
22 **Interim Associate Vice Chancellor, Student Development & Diversity; and Jodi**  
23 **Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Student Development, Student Development &**  
24 **Diversity.**
