CLASSIFICATION CONTINUING THE HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY FOR THE
2007-2008 ACADEMIC YEAR

CHARLIER, STUDENT BODY VICE PRESIDENT

1 **WHEREAS, Student Senate has historically provided health insurance for our**
2 **students through an Agent of Record; and**

3 **WHEREAS, providing this service helps protect students against**
4 **unnecessary financial risks due to unpredicted occurrences; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the current contract will soon expire; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it has been recommended that we change the minimum credit**
7 **requirements for purchasing the health insurance to five (5) credits to**
8 **accommodate part-time Graduate School students; and**

9 **WHEREAS, it will be more cost-effective for students if a preferred provider**
10 **network is adopted; and**

11 **WHEREAS, because the 50th session approved a rate guarantee for no**
12 **more than 10% for 2007-2008 and 2008-2009, the rate will only increase that**

13 amount instead of the potential larger amount; and

14 WHEREAS, the coverage will remain the same as 2006-2007 for the 2007-
15 2008 and 2008-2009 academic years;

16 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate approves the
17 renewal bid by Columbian Life for a 10% increase from \$695.00 to \$765.00 for
18 students under 31 years of age and \$905.00 to \$996.00 for students 31 years of
19 age and older; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate approves the Health
21 EOS+ preferred provider network; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate changes the minimum
23 credit requirements to five (5) to accommodate Graduate School students; and

24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President French transmit
25 copies of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Andrew Soll, Vice
26 Chancellor, Business & Student Services; Dr. Steven Tallant, Interim Provost/Vice
27 Chancellor; Don Southard, Insurance Agent of Record; Dr. Kimberly Barrett,
28 Associate Vice Chancellor, Student Development & Diversity; Jodi Thesing-Ritter,
29 Associate Dean of Student Development, Student Development & Diversity; and
30 Mary Ryan-Miller, Associate Dean of Student Development.
