INTRODUCED BY RAYMOND FRENCH, STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT, MEGHAN CHARLIER, STUDENT BODY VICE PRESIDENT AND DAVID MCCARTHY, TREASURER AND OFF-CAMPUS SENATOR

1 WHEREAS, the Phase II Orientation Welcome Convocation, in September,
2 typically draws over 2,000 incoming freshman; and

3 WHEREAS, Student Senate needs to be more visible to the student body,
4 especially to incoming freshmen; and

5 WHEREAS, funding the ice cream social and promotion would be a means
6 of displaying Student Senate to these incoming freshman;

7 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate approves funding the
8 ice cream social for an amount up to \$300, while also including \$100 for
9 promotional items, for a total of \$400; and

10 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President French transmit
11 copies of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Kimberly Barrett,

12 **Associate Vice Chancellor, Student Development & Diversity; and Jodi Thesing-**

13 **Ritter, Associate Dean of Student Development, Student Development & Diversity.**
