UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF MORE DUPLEX PRINTERS ON CAMPUS

1 WHEREAS, duplex printers are currently only located in the
2 Old Library Computer Lab and the Library Computer Lab; and

3 WHEREAS, the use of duplex printers reduces the amount of
4 paper used in half; and

5 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire has
6 recently signed on to the President's Climate Commitment, an
7 organization dedicated to helping campuses become more "green;"
8 and

9 WHEREAS, some professors require or suggest that students
10 print off all PowerPoint slides to aid them during lectures; and

11 WHEREAS, some lectures have many slides and cause students
12 to use large amounts of paper; and

13 WHEREAS, students often print research documents or other
14 academic documents consisting of large amounts of paper; and

15 WHEREAS, many students are forced to waste paper because
16 duplex printers are not always available; and

17 WHEREAS, many students see the need to help make our campus
18 more environmentally friendly; and

19 WHEREAS installing the duplex printers on a five year
20 rotation will allow for problems to be resolved should they
21 arise; and

22 WHEREAS, the funds for duplex printers can come from the
23 Information Technology Budget; and

24 WHEREAS Housing and Residence Life is responsible for
25 maintaining computer facilities in the residence halls; and

26 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that this body respectfully
27 requests Housing and Residence Life to consider purchasing
28 duplex printers for all residence hall labs; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that duplex printers will be set as
30 the default printer; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that duplex printers be incorporated
32 into the ITC academic building printer rotation on the existing
33 five year cycle; and

34 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage President Raymond
