STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF STUDENT OVERSIGHT OF REMODELING EFFORTS IN  
DAVIES' ORGANIZATION COMPLEX AND STUDENT SENATE OFFICE

1           WHEREAS, the Organizations Complex and Student Senate Office  
2 are being remodeled; and

3           WHEREAS, these areas are for use by students and their  
4 organizations; and

5           WHEREAS, the Student Body should have final say over a  
6 remodeling of areas that are for their use; and

7           WHEREAS, currently, a select few have a seat on the  
8 committee which is deciding the format of these offices; and

9           WHEREAS, student organizations have been caught off-guard by  
10 the impending eviction from their cubes; and

11           WHEREAS, there is some significant reservation about the  
12 remodeling efforts; and

13           WHEREAS, organizations that require space for logistical  
14 purposes on campus deserve a dedicated workspace for their  
15 organization; and

16           WHEREAS, remodeling of these areas should not be taken  
17 lightly; and

18           WHEREAS, Student Senate represents the student body; and

19           WHEREAS, the Organizations Council is an informal group  
20 without voting procedures;

21           BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate should be  
22 given voting rights and the power to approve or disapprove of the  
23 remodeling plan in both the Student Senate Office and the  
24 Organizations Complex; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the final plans for remodeling  
26 be presented to the Student Senate for approval or disapproval in  
27 resolution form; and

28           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate's future vote  
29 on the plan should be heeded by the Remodeling Committee; and

30           BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage President Raymond  
31 French transmit copies of this resolution to Charles Farrell,  
32 Director, University Centers; Beverly Soll, Chair, Remodeling  
33 Committee; all members of the Remodeling Committee; and Jodi  
34 Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Student Development, Student  
35 Development & Diversity.
