INTRODUCED BY THOMAS HOLTAN, FINANCE COMMISSION DIRECTOR AND THE  
FINANCE COMMISSION

1           WHEREAS, THE Athletics Department requested \$4,850 on behalf of  
2 University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Men's and Women's Intercollegiate Ice  
3 Hockey programs; and

4           WHEREAS, the Athletics Department's request meets the four criteria to  
5 qualify for a special allocation; and

6           WHEREAS, the rising fees of the Hobbs Ice Arena were unknown, thus  
7 unable to be anticipated in the previous budget cycles; and

8           WHEREAS, the Athletics Department waited for a special allocation request  
9 to ask for more money, because they wanted to be certain that the fee increase  
10 would happen before projecting it in their budget; and

11           WHEREAS, the Athletics Department has been completely transparent with  
12 the Finance Commission in predicting this unfortunate fee increase; and

13           WHEREAS, specifically, the increase is \$115 per hour for ice rental to \$130

14 per hour for ice rental; and

15 WHEREAS, funding this Special Allocation Request would provide support  
16 to our Hockey programs, which are a crucial part of our Athletics program; and

17 WHEREAS, the Finance Commission voted 12-0-1 in support of allocating  
18 \$4,850 to the Athletics Department;

19 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate allocates \$4,850 to the  
20 Athletics Department; and

21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Lauer transmit a  
22 copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Marty Wood,  
23 Interim Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. V. Thomas Dock, Acting Vice Chancellor,  
24 Administration, Facilities & Finance; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student  
25 Affairs; Dave Gessner, Director, Business Services; Scott Kilgallon, Director,  
26 Athletics Department; and Jodi Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Students, Dean  
27 of Students Office.
