INTRODUCED BY THOMAS HOLTAN, FINANCE COMMISSION DIRECTOR AND THE  
FINANCE COMMISSION

1           **WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System**  
2 **requires that each campus has a Segregated University Fee Allocation Committee**  
3 **(SUFAC) to appropriate portions of the segregated fee; and**

4           **WHEREAS, at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, the Student Senate**  
5 **has this responsibility; and**

6           **WHEREAS, the Student Senate Finance Commission reviews each**  
7 **proposed budget and gives the Senate its recommendations; and**

8           **WHEREAS, this said commission has completed its process of research,**  
9 **review, budget hearings, appellate hearings, and deliberations upon which it has**  
10 **adopted recommendations for both the 2009-2010 Organized Activities Budget**  
11 **and for the two-year (2010-2011, 2011-2012) minimum funding levels for Athletics**  
12 **and Recreation;**

13 **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate:**

14 **a. Adopt the Organized Activities Budget recommendations (Attachment**  
15 **“A”); and**

16 **b. Adopt the following two-year minimum funding requirements for**  
17 **Athletics and Recreation; and**

18 **c. Funding for these recommendations shall come from the 2009-**  
19 **2010 Organized Activity Fee of \$315.00 per full-time student; and**

20 **d. Recognizes that Bill 47-B-14 committed \$75,000 to the principle**  
21 **balance of \$300,000 for the Carson Park Resurfacing Project, and**  
22 **\$22,500 to be paid each year for the following ten years; and**

23 **e. Recognizes that Bill 51-B-14 committed \$250,000 to the Hobbs**  
24 **Ice Arena Renovation, and recognizes that Bill 52-B-3 committed**  
25 **an additional \$50,000 to the Hobbs Ice Arena Renovation; and**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Lauer transmit a**  
27 **copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Marty Wood,**  
28 **Interim Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. V. Thomas Dock, Acting Vice Chancellor,**  
29 **Administration, Facilities & Finance; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student**  
30 **Affairs; Dave Gessner, Director, Business Services; and Jodi Thesing-Ritter,**  
31 **Associate Dean of Students, Dean of Students Office.**
