4 WHEREAS, Attachment "A" is a summary of the proposed awards
5 for FY 2009-2010; and

6 WHEREAS, each of the proposed awards is within the ranges
7 set forth by Student Senate; and

8 WHEREAS, two specific Student Senate concerns are addressed
9 with the awards this cycle; and

10 WHEREAS, the first of these initiatives, correcting the
11 concerns with the FYE program, have been observed by the
12 Provost's office, including the appointment of a new director of
13 FYE; and

14 WHEREAS, the second of these initiatives, advertizing the
15 innovative projects category to have money available to go
16 towards strategic plan initiatives, has received exciting new
17 proposals; and

18 WHEREAS, the Provost's office supports the role of students
19 in the Differential Tuition process;

20 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate supports the
21 proposed awards of Differential Tuition for FY 2009-2010; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Student Senate appreciates
23 student impact in this process and supports continuance of these
24 initiatives; and
