STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM SERVICE LEARNING
FACULTY WAGES TO THE INNOVATIVE PROJECTS CATEGORY

1 WHEREAS, the Provost's office has recently reviewed and
2 evaluated the Differential Tuition proposals for FY 2009-2010;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Differential Tuition is defined as funding for
5 programs that enhance student learning and is generally awarded
6 to programs that are supplemental to a student's education; and

7 WHEREAS, Service Learning is an academic requirement for
8 graduation and does not completely fall under the traditional
9 "supplemental" scope of Differential Tuition; and

10 WHEREAS, budget item SL 4 currently contains 75% of the
11 salary of the Director of Service Learning; and

12 WHEREAS, the Academic Affairs Commission feels that DT
13 should not fund a faculty position; and

14 WHEREAS, the Academic Affairs Commission proposes a 50/50
15 split of said salary between DT and the Provost's budget, rather
16 than the current 75/25 split; and

17 WHEREAS, the Academic Affairs Commission proposes that the
18 extra money made available go to fund the exciting proposals in
19 the Innovative Projects category;

20 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate supports a 25%
21 shift in the salary of the Director of Service Learning from DT
22 to the Provost's budget; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Student Senate appreciates the
24 student impact in this process and hopes for the continuance of
25 the partnership between the Student Senate and the Provost's
26 office; and

27 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage President Lauer
28 transmit copies of this resolution to Dr. Brian Levin-
29 Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Marty Wood, Interim Provost/Vice
30 Chancellor; Dr. V. Thomas Dock, Acting Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth
31 Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr. Marc Goulet,
32 Interim Associate Dean, Dean of Students Office; and Jodi
33 Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Students, Dean of Students
34 Office.
