3 Attachment "A"); and

4 WHEREAS, even with the high number of accomplishments that
5 our athletics program has achieved, the attendance at most
6 athletic events is fairly low; and

7 WHEREAS, athletics promotes school spirit and healthy
8 competition between other universities; and

9 WHEREAS, steps need to be taken to promote the visibility
10 of athletic events;

11 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that a committee be created to
12 research the attendance issues at our athletic events; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee create and
14 implement, if possible, recommendations to promote athletic
15 events; and
