STUDENT SENATE LOGO

3 WHEREAS, having a competition would not only get a new logo
4 for senate, but it would give more name recognition for Student
5 Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, a new Student Senate Logo competition would get
7 many students involved in their elected body; and

8 WHEREAS, a new Student Senate Logo would be more
9 aesthetically pleasing to all who look at it; and

10 WHEREAS, having a new Student Senate Logo would better
11 represent out senate; and

12 WHEREAS, a new Student Senate Logo would evoke the students
13 creativity and talents for a good purpose;

14 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that a competition committee be
15 created to review the submissions for a new Student Senate Logo;
16 and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall review the
18 submissions and decide on the top three entries; and

19 Be IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the top three entries would be
20 put to a vote by the Student Senate to decide which Senate logo
21 would best represent the Student Senate in the University
22 community, and the state; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the winner of the competition
24 will receive a prize/reward TBD by the Eau Claire Foundation;
25 and

26 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage President Tim
27 Lauer transmit copies of this resolution to Dr. Brian Levin-
28 Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Marty Wood, Interim Provost/Vice
29 Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs;
30 and Jodi Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Students, Dean of
31 Students Office.
