CLASSIFICATION SPECIAL ALLOCATION TO ATHLETICS FOR MEN'S AND

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

INTRODUCED BY DYLAN JAMBREK, FINANCE COMMISSION DIRECTOR AND  
FINANCE COMMISSION

1 WHEREAS, the Athletics Department has requested \$5,240 for the Men's  
2 and Women's basketball teams; and

3 WHEREAS, the NCAA has mandated a change in movable rings and shot  
4 clock displays; and

5 WHEREAS, the NCAA has mandated the movable rings change for safety  
6 reasons so that the ring may flex in all directions; and

7 WHEREAS, the NCAA has mandated a visual display of the end of the shot  
8 clock; and

9 WHEREAS, the cost of the two movable rings is estimated at \$370 for each  
10 or \$740 for both; and

11 WHEREAS, the shot clock displays will cost \$4,500; and

12 WHEREAS, Athletics is getting a cheaper price on shot clock displays due

13 to their current work with Daktronics for other activities; and

14 WHEREAS, without these changes, UW-Eau Claire could not host  
15 basketball games; and

16 WHEREAS, the Athletics Department has been historically responsible and  
17 frugal regarding its budgets; and

18 WHEREAS, the Athletics Department already fundraises for a large portion  
19 of its budget; and

20 WHEREAS, the Finance Commission voted unanimously in favor of the  
21 allocation;

22 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the UW-Eau Claire Student Senate  
23 grants the special allocation of \$5,240 to the Athletics Department; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the allocation will be taken out of the  
25 carryover balance; and

26 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Umhoefer  
27 transmit a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia  
28 Kleine, Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student  
29 Affairs; Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget and Finance; Scott Kilgallon,  
30 Director, Intercollegiate Athletics; and Jodi Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of  
31 Students, Dean of Students Office.
