WHEREAS, Student Senate has historically provided health insurance for our students through an Agent of Record; and

WHEREAS, providing this service helps protect students against unnecessary financial risks due to unpredicted occurrences (see Attachment "A"); and

WHEREAS, the current contract will expire August 26, 2010; and

WHEREAS, because the 53rd session approved a rate guarantee for no more than 10% for 2010-2011; and

WHEREAS, the coverage will remain the same as the 2009-2010 academic year; and

WHEREAS, our Agent of Record has negotiated a plan with no rate increase;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate approves the renewal bid by Columbian Life for a rate of \$897 for students under 31 years of age and \$1168 for students 31 years of age and older; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate approves a guaranteed rate renewal at no more than 10% for the academic year 2011-2012; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost/Vice Chancellor; Don Southard, Insurance Agent of Record; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget and Finance; Dr. Susan Harrison, Chair, University Senate; Jodi Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Students, Dean of Students Office; and Dr. Marc Goulet, Interim Associate Dean of Students, Dean of Students Office.
