CLASSIFICATION STUDENT TECHNOLOGY FEE ALLOCATION TO THE LIBRARY FOR
TWO ADDITIONAL GROUP STUDY STATIONS

DIRECTOR AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

1 WHEREAS, reconfiguring the layout of the computers on the first floor of
2 the Library provides the necessary space for two additional group study stations;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the existing group study stations on the first floor of the
5 Library have been used increasingly over the past years; and

6 WHEREAS, implementation of this proposal would create two additional
7 technology-equipped spaces for students to work until 1:00 a.m.; and

8 WHEREAS, the Library is requesting funding for two thirty-inch Dell
9 UltraSharp monitors with three year warranties for \$2,368.42 total (\$1,184.21 per
10 monitor; and

11 WHEREAS, the Library is requesting four chairs for \$400.00 total (\$100.00

12 per chair); and

13 WHEREAS, the Library will provide two computers and two chairs, as well
14 as cover the costs for setting up the new group stations; and

15 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission voted 4-0-1 in favor of
16 this allocation;

17 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate authorizes the
18 allocation of \$2,768.42 to the Library for two additional group study stations; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this allocation shall come from the
20 Student Technology Fee contingency fund; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this be included in future Student
22 Technology Fee budget ranges as part of the equipment rotation as necessary;
23 and

24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit
25 a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine,
26 Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr.
27 Brian Carlisle, Dean of Students; Dr. Susan Harrison, Chair, University Senate;
28 Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget & Finance; Craig Mey, Director,
29 Learning and Technology Services; Carol Accola, Associate Director, Learning
30 and Technology Services; John Pollitz, Director, McIntyre Library; and Bryan
31 Vogh, Head of Systems, McIntyre Library.
