AN OPEN COMPUTER DISPLAY

DIRECTOR AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

1 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission and Student Senate
2 have made several requests for creative solutions to increasing accessibility to
3 computers despite budget cuts; and

4 WHEREAS, Learning and Technology Services revamped the Computer
5 Lab website (<http://spaces.uwec.edu/>); and

6 WHEREAS, the Computer Lab website displays the number of open
7 computers in labs, the software installed on lab computers, and other computer
8 lab information; and

9 WHEREAS, the Library used a computer from their pool of replacement lab
10 computers to act as a server that displays the Computer lab website on a large-
11 screen LCD monitor; and

12 **WHEREAS, the Library put this service into effect prior to funding approval**
13 **as a service to the students; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Library is reusing a retired LCD monitor from a group study**
15 **room to keep costs to this service to a minimum; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Library is requesting \$613.80 for one Dell Optiplex 780**
17 **computer to provide this service on a long-term basis; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission voted 4-0-1 in favor of**
19 **this allocation;**

20 **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate authorizes the**
21 **allocation of \$613.80 to the Library for one Dell Optiplex 780 computer; and**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this allocation shall come from the**
23 **Student Technology Fee contingency fund; and**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this equipment be included in future**
25 **Student Technology Fee budget ranges as part of the equipment rotation as**
26 **necessary; and**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit**
28 **a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine,**
29 **Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr.**
