CLASSIFICATION STUDENT TECHNOLOGY FEE ALLOCATION TO THE EQUIPMENT
CHECKOUT PROGRAM FOR TRIPODS

INTRODUCED BY MATTHEW SIAS, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION
DIRECTOR AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

1 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission last funded tripods
2 for the Equipment Checkout Program during the Student Senate's 50th Session;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, more still cameras and video cameras have been added to the
5 Equipment Checkout Program each year since the 50th Session; and

6 WHEREAS, use of tripods has continued to increase each year for the past
7 few years; and

8 WHEREAS, the Equipment Checkout Program currently has 55 still/video
9 cameras that can use tripods but only 13 working tripods; and

10 WHEREAS, the Library, on behalf of the Equipment Checkout Program, is
11 requesting \$462.15 to purchase 15 new tripods (\$30.81 per tripod); and

12 WHEREAS, the tripods will be ordered in bulk to keep the ordering cost
13 low; and

14 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission voted 4-0-1 in favor of
15 this allocation;

16 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate authorizes the
17 allocation of \$462.15 to the Library for the purchase of 15 tripods for the
18 Equipment Checkout Program; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this allocation shall come from the
20 Student Technology Fee contingency fund; and

21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit
22 a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine,
23 Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr.
