WHEREAS, in February, 2010, the Board of Regents approved the Blugold Commitment; and

WHEREAS, the Blugold Commitment outlined a stringent policy of student, faculty and administration oversight; and

WHEREAS, the office of Academic Affairs received 80 total proposals to be funded through differential tuition; and

WHEREAS, three categorical committees were formed, Teaching & Learning, Research & Innovative Projects, and Experiential Learning; and

WHEREAS, these categorical committees ranked the proposals based upon impact in relation to student learning, alignment with established goals and criteria, and assessment plan; and

WHEREAS, the Funding Analysis Committee allocated the differential

tuition awards as outlined in Attachment “A;” and

WHEREAS, the Blugold Commitment Differential Tuition Bylaws call for Student Senate to approve the final Differential Tuition allocations by a 2/3 vote;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate adopt the Differential Tuition Allocations for FY 2010-2011 outlined in Attachment “A;” and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate adopt the Provost Initiative funding levels outlined in Attachment “B”; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget and Finance; Dr. Susan Harrison, Chair, University Senate; and Jodi Thesing-Ritter, Associate Dean of Students, Dean of Students Office.
