1 WHEREAS, Earth Week is the most important awareness and outreach
2 event for environmental sustainability at UWEC; and

3 WHEREAS, this Earth Week will strive to create a sense of a sustainable
4 UWEC community and campus; and

5 WHEREAS, faculty, students and Eau Claire community members will be
6 encouraged to attend and participate in a variety of events including film
7 screenings, musical acts, EEC awareness and relevant student organization
8 awareness; and

9 WHEREAS, the event take place from April 19 through April 21; and

10 WHEREAS, each of these days will have a different educational theme; and

11 WHEREAS, musical acts include: UWEC student Anastasia Davis, UWEC
12 professor Joel Pace's band Irie Sol, and regionally renowned Roster McCabe; and

13 WHEREAS, thought provoking environmental movies include: Zeigesit;
14 Moving Forward; the Story of Stuff; Off the Grid with Les Stroud; The Age of
15 Stupid; and Home; and

16 WHEREAS, students/staff/faculty will be encouraged to bike to campus
17 rather than drive through incentives such as raffle prizes; and

18 WHEREAS, Earth Week would facilitate a dialogue of sustainability
19 between the campus and the community; and

20 WHEREAS, this dialogue will be an opportunity for networking among local
21 environmental organizations as well as between students and local employers;

23 WHEREAS, data collection will be done through an environmental survey
24 that we will use to characterize students' viewpoints on environmental issues;
25 and

26 WHEREAS, the Environmental Endeavors Commission voted unanimously
27 through voice vote to approve this expenditure; and

28 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate authorizes the
29 expenditure of \$1354.53 as displayed in Attachment A; and

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this expenditure shall be drawn from the
31 Environmental Endeavors account; and

32 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit
