1 WHEREAS, on April 12, 2010 Student Senate passed Bill 53-B-19 “In
2 Support of Differential Tuition Bylaw Adaption;” and

3 WHEREAS, the approved Bylaws were only in effect for the fiscal yar, July
4 1, 2010 through July 1, 2011; and

5 WHEREAS, the Academic Affairs Commission Director is required to
6 annually make revisions to the Differential Tuition Bylaws and submit them to the
7 Student Senate for approval; and

8 WHEREAS, the proposed Bylaw changes more accurately represent the
9 Blugold Commitment allocation process; and

10 WHEREAS, the proposed Bylaw changes reaffirm the role of students in
11 the Categorical Committees and Funding Analysis Committee; and

12 WHEREAS, the Bylaw changes more clearly define the role of the Student
13 Senate in oversight and approval of Differential Tuition bills; and

14 WHEREAS, the Academic Affairs Commission approved the Bylaw
15 revisions by a vote of 6-0-0;

16 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate approve the proposed
17 2011-2012 Differential Tuition Bylaws outlined in Attachment "A;" and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bylaws will take effect starting July 1,
19 2011 and will be valid until July 1, 2012; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Academic Affairs Commission
21 Director should resubmit the Bylaws with any recommendations for revision to
22 the Student Senate for approval in the Spring Semester of 2012; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if no revisions are made the bylaws as
24 they stand will continue to govern the differential tuition process for the following
25 fiscal year; and

26 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit
27 a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine,
28 Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr.
29 Brian Carlisle, Dean of Students; Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget &
30 Finance; Dr. Susan Harrison, Chair, University Senate; Stephanie Jamelske,
31 Academic Affairs Budget Officer, Academic Affairs; and Dr. Michael Wick,
32 Associate Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs.
