INTRODUCED BY MATTHEW SIAS, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

DIRECTOR AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

1           WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission's Student Technology  
2 Survey conducted in March 2011 indicated a desire for greater accessibility to  
3 computers and printers on campus; and

4           WHEREAS, as a response to these results, the Information Technology  
5 Commission has made attempts to put additional computers and printers in three  
6 campus buildings; and

7           WHEREAS, only the Human Sciences and Services (HSS) Building  
8 Management has shown interest in adding additional computers and printers;  
9 and

10           WHEREAS, a final location for the computers and printers will need to be  
11 agreed upon by the Space Allocation Committee, the HSS Building Management,

12 **Facilities Planning, and Learning and Technology Services; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the location will not be finalized until Student Senate is**  
14 **recessed for the summer; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the exact cost of network and electrical work can only be**  
16 **estimated until a location is finalized; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the exact costs of equipment will not be known before Student**  
18 **Senate is recessed for the summer; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the cost of the desktop computers is estimated to be \$750.00;**  
20 **and**

21 **WHEREAS, the cost of furniture varies depending on what is available in**  
22 **surplus sales; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission voted 4-0-0 in favor of**  
24 **this allocation;**

25 **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Student Senate authorizes the**  
26 **allocation of up to \$10,000.00 to Learning and Technology Services to spend on**  
27 **six desktop computers with monitors, one duplexing printer, furniture for the**  
28 **station, any necessary electrical work, and any necessary network runs during**  
29 **the summer of 2011; and**

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this allocation shall come from the**  
31 **Student Technology Fee Contingency Fund; and**

32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any funds not directly required for this**  
33 **project be returned to the Student Technology Fee Contingency Fund upon the**  
34 **completion of the project; and**

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding is contingent upon a location for**

36 the computer and printer station in HSS being agreed upon by the Space  
37 Allocation Committee, the HSS Building Management, Facilities Planning, and  
38 Learning and Technology Services; and

39 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that upon passage, President Jambrek transmit  
40 a copy of this bill to Dr. Brian Levin-Stankevich, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine,  
41 Provost/Vice Chancellor; Dr. Beth Hellwig, Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs; Dr.  
42 Brian Carlisle, Dean of Students; Dave Gessner, Assistant Chancellor, Budget &  
43 Finance; Dr. Susan Harrison, Chair, University Senate; Craig Mey, Director,  
44 Learning & Technology Services; Carol Accola, Associate Director, Learning &  
45 Technology Services; Greg Rineck, IS Services, Learning & Technology Services;
