

**INFORMATION ON ADVANCED PLACEMENT SCORES
FOR STUDENTS WHO TOOK TESTS PRIOR TO THEIR SENIOR YEAR**

If you took AP tests prior to your senior year and they are not appearing on your record, you fall into one of three categories:

- 1) If you took an additional AP test your **senior year** and had that score sent to us, AND included your correct social security number or AP number on all your tests, we will get all your scores. If you aren't sure, you can wait to see if all your credit appears on the transcript we send in July. **PLEASE CHECK THE TRANSCRIPT WE SEND YOU CAREFULLY.**

- 2) If you only took an AP test during your junior year and you think you **had the score sent to UW-Eau Claire**, contact the Academic Testing Office (836-5522) or email Debbie Gough (goughdm@uwec.edu) and we will check to see if we received your scores.

- 3) If you did not take an AP test your senior year and did not send the earlier score to UW-Eau Claire, you have three options:
 - ◆ You can bring your copy of the score report to Academic Testing, Schofield 226 in the fall. (DO NOT MAIL IT)

 - ◆ You can go to your high school and get a copy of their copy. Ask them to put the school seal on the copy. This can be mailed to Academic Testing, UW-Eau Claire, 105 Garfield Avenue, P.O. Box 4004, Eau Claire, WI 54702-4004.

 - ◆ You can contact AP and have the score(s) sent to us.

Send the following:

- Name, sex and date of birth
- AP number (if you have it) and Social Security Number
- Year you took the AP exam(s)
- Check payable to AP exams in the amount of \$15.00 or credit card information (for phone requests, a credit card is necessary)
