# Ports of Call

## TANGIER, MOROCCO

Explore the Mendoubia Gardens which contain a fascinating banyan tree that is more than 800 years old. The Caves of Hercules are 9 miles west of Tangier in the Cap Spartel area, a place of great beauty and archeological significance.

## SEVILLE (CADIZ), SPAIN

Spend a fabulous day in Seville visiting the magnificent cathedral, climbing the famed Giralda tower and strolling through the gorgeous Alcazar and its gardens. See the ceramic-encrusted Plaza de España and stroll through the alleys of Barrio de Santa Cruz. Or explore the Andalusian wine country and Jerez, the home of sherry. Don't miss the charm of Cádiz with its gracious squares, flower-filled parks on the city bastions and its bustling markets.

## MALAGA, SPAIN

Andalusia's cultural capital, Malaga is an invigorating mix of old and new. Narrow cobblestone streets and leafy boulevards lead to lush gardens, stately monuments, trendy shops, and a pulsating nightlife. The birthplace of Pablo Picasso, Malaga is home to a renowned museum devoted to the artist.

## ALICANTE, SPAIN

Capital of the Costa Blanca, Alicante is one of Spain's most intriguing cities, distinctively Spanish with African undertones. Scenic beaches, palm-lined avenues, fresh seafood restaurants and a beautiful yacht harbor, all combine to make Alicante a true seaside getaway.

## IBIZA, SPAIN

Fields of olive and fig trees, sandy beaches, secluded coves, whitewashed houses and a world famous nightlife make Ibiza an island paradise. Named "Island of Pine Trees" by the Greeks, much of the Spanish isle's rugged landscape is marked by thick, rustic forests and jagged cliffs.

## BARCELONA, SPAIN

Visit the magnificent Gothic Cathedral and the amazing La Sagrada Familia, Antoni Gaudí's unfinished masterpiece. Enjoy the lovely Montjuic Gardens, Gaudí's other fabulous structures; the charming squares of the old Gothic Quarter and Las Ramblas, Barcelona's famed downtown promenade. Or visit beautiful Montserrat and its monastery, in a breathtaking setting high in the mountains.

## ST. TROPEZ, FRANCE

Enjoy the exquisite hilly Provençal countryside beyond this resort and its charming villages with their narrow stepped streets, lovely churches and stunning scenic views. Visit a local winery or take a drive along the rugged coast and revel in the wonderful views of the landscape.

## CANNES, FRANCE

Strolling along the sun-kissed and sophisticated sidewalks of Cannes, it is hard to believe that it was once just a sleepy fisherman's village. This cosmopolitan city is now home to the world-renowned International Film Festival, glitzy casinos and hotels, endless designer boutiques, and pristine beaches.

## MONTE CARLO, MONACO

Take in sparkling Monaco as you drive along the famous Grand Corniche, then stroll through the old quarter. See the pink palace of the Grimaldis, visit the Casino, explore the Côte d'Azur from Nice to Cannes, Grasse and the lovely St. Paul de Vence, each a jewel to savor.

## PORTOFINO, ITALY

Portofino and Santa Margherita define the word "picturesque." Stunning scenery continues in the beautiful coastal resorts of Ravello, Sestri Levante and San Fruttuoso.

## FLORENCE/PISA (LIVORNO), ITALY

Explore the fabled architecture of Renaissance Florence: the Duomo with Brunelleschi's dome, the Baptistry, Michelangelo's David, the bridge over the Arno and the Uffizi Gallery. Visit Pisa's superb Field of Miracles and the iconic Leaning Tower. Or lose yourself in the Tuscan countryside and the towns of Siena, and San Gimignano renowned for its medieval towers.
