CJ 427	Advanced Reporting	3	Sophomore; C or above in CJ 300 and 321; 2.5 GPA
CJ 429	Journalism Seminar (Capstone)	3	Senior; C or above in CJ 222, 300 and 321; completion of CJ 335 or CJ 427; completion of or concurrent enrollment in 412 and 414; 2.5 GPA
