Student must show proof of active involvement in UWEC communication or mass communication related student organization (e.g., CJO, PRSSA, SHRM, SOPC, SRI, TV-10, WUEC-FM, etc.) and/or employment and/or an internship in a communication or mass communication related field (e.g. WEAU-TV, WQOW-TV, Post House, WPR, Luther-Midelfort, United Way, etc.) at the time of application.
