- Assume responsibility for the duties involved with mentoring, including setting a model for others, attending required meetings and activities on time, and becoming familiar with policies and procedures associated with Camp Campus.
- Participate in all activities required and encourage participation of the campers with whom you are working.
- Keep supervisory staff aware of any potential issues.
- Follow the rules and regulations outlined in the mentor training.
- Perform other duties as required.
