CALENDAR DAY PARKING REGULATIONS

The Eau Claire Police Department is reminding citizens that calendar day parking regulations in the City of Eau Claire are in effect from November 1 to May 1.

WARNING

CALENDAR DAY PARKING REGULATIONS

Between November 1 and May 1, alternate side parking regulations are in effect on all streets in the City of Eau Claire:

- A. On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having odd-numbered addresses.
- B. On even-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having even-numbered addresses.
- C. This ordinance shall only be in effect between midnight and 7:00 a.m.
- D. This ordinance shall not supersede more restrictive parking regulations in effect in the city, such as during snow emergencies on "Snow Emergency Routes," "No Parking 2 a.m. - 6 a.m." Zones, etc. You must still abide by those rules as well.

CALENDAR DAY PARKING REGULATIONS

Between November 1 and May 1, alternate side parking regulations are in effect on **all streets** in the City of Eau Claire:

- A. On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having odd-numbered addresses.
- B. On even-numbered days, vehicles shall only be parked, stopped or left standing on that side of the street having even-numbered addresses.
- C. This ordinance shall only be in effect between midnight and 7:00 a.m.
- D. This ordinance shall not supersede more restrictive parking regulations in effect in the city, such as during snow emergencies on "Snow Emergency Routes," "No Parking 2 a.m. - 6 a.m." Zones, etc. You must still abide by those rules as well.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Failure to pay or contest this citation within 10 days of the issued date will result in additional penalties. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation will suspend your vehicle registration and refuse registration of any of your vehicles if you fail to pay this citation within 28 days from the issued date. If you have unpaid parking citations your vehicle may be towed and impounded.
