The UW-Eau Claire Office of Multicultural Affairs sponsors the following programs that give socio-economically disadvantaged youth the opportunity to visit the UW-Eau Claire campus while developing communication and leadership skills necessary for higher education.

### Youth Leadership

Grades 8-11 | July 11-24, 2009

The goal of this two-week camp is to prepare students for higher education, improve students' academic success, increase students' knowledge of the Hmong language and culture, and prepare students to be leaders of tomorrow. Students will learn math, English, science, leadership, and Hmong culture and language literacy skills through class lectures, field trips, hands-on activities and discussions.

### Math and Science Summer Program

Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) Only

Grades 6-12 | June 21-27, 2009

Interested in math and science? Check out this program designed to increase scientific and mathematical thinking, questioning and reasoning skills, while stimulating your interest in math and the sciences. Participants do not need to have a background in science or math, only an interest in the subjects and a desire to learn more about life on a college campus.

### Strengthening Our Nations

Grades 8-9 and 10-11 | July 5 - 18, 2009

In this program you will focus three areas of college student development. The first area involves higher education leadership, the second will build awareness for language and culture and the third area will focus on reading comprehension and writing.

### Opening Doors

Grades 9-10 | June 7-13, 2009

The goal of this program is to reinforce English and Spanish literacy skills and create and maintain a connection to Latino history and culture. The one-week camp includes an academic component that emphasizes reading, science, writing and critical thinking skills that you will apply through fun-filled activities both on and off campus.

### The program includes:

- Tuition.
- On-campus residence hall room.
- Three meals a day.
- Field trips.
- Group photo and T-shirt.
- Recreation.
- Transportation.
