### **CERTIFICATE IN LGBTQ STUDIES**

**FROM:** Page 198 of the *2014-15 Undergraduate Catalog*

**TO:** 1. In the section, "The remaining 6 credits are to be selected from:"

- Drop WMNS 440 Lesbian Lives and Cultures
- Add newly-created course WMNS 308 Topics in LGBTQ Studies
- Add WMNS/HIST 313 Gender, Sex, and Science in European History
- Add "internships" so that the last sentence reads, "Special topics, internships, and umbrella courses with a focus on LGBTQ and/or sexualities issues may be applied to the certificate program electives with the approval of the Women's Studies Program Director."

2. Remove the minimum GPA requirement required for course and certificate completion.

3. Include the following stipulation in the paragraph prior to the listing of the certificate requirements:

"For students pursuing the Women's Studies Major and the LGBTQ Certificate as their first and second programs to meet graduation requirements, no course may be counted in both the major and the certificate."
