2. Possess a deep concern for the overall mission of the university.
3. Take a student-centered approach to his or her work, which contributes to the overall development of students at the university.
4. Exhibit an appreciation for diverse cultural perspectives.

STUDENT ASSISTANT AWARD

The recipient will:

1. Be a student working within a Student Development and Diversity unit.
2. Exhibit creativity and enthusiasm for the work he or she is doing.
3. Show appreciation for the diverse interests and needs of students and staff.

DIVERSITY TEACHER/SCHOLAR AWARD

The recipient will:

1. Be a member of the university community (faculty or staff).
2. Engage in a multicultural approach to the teaching and learning process.
3. Illustrate an understanding of and enthusiasm for the critical role diversity plays in teaching and learning.

DIVERSITY ADVOCATE AWARD

This recipient will:

1. Be a member of the university community (student, faculty or staff).
2. Promote diversity efforts at the university and in the community.
3. Create a welcoming environment for diverse students, employees and campus visitors.
4. Support programming that celebrates the unique contributions of diverse groups.
