Medication and ADHD on *The West Side*

The prevalence and effects of overdiagnosing children with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) will be the topic of *The West Side* on Tuesday, December 11 at 5 p.m. on 88.3 WHWC Menomonie-Eau Claire.

Host Mary Jo Wagner will talk with William Frankenberger, psychology professor at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire and director of the Human Development Center. He's working with the Department of Public Instruction to revise the state's guidelines for identifying children with learning disabilities. Vicki Dowell is Coordinator of Special Education in the Eau Claire elementary schools and Mort Sipress is a parent of two who used Ritalin for their learning disabilities.
