GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission Requirements--Marshfield site

Students wishing to pursue a nursing degree through UW-Eau Claire at the Marshfield site, must first be accepted to UW-Eau Claire. Students can complete the online University application at www.uwec.edu. In addition, formal application to UW-Eau Claire's professional nursing program is required. Students are encouraged to apply to the nursing program during the semester in which 30 transferable credits and 3 of the 5 required sciences will be completed. **Deadline dates for filing an admission application** to the nursing program are **December 1** or **May 1**. Accepted **December 1** applicants start their nursing courses the following fall semester. Accepted **May 1** applicants start their nursing courses the following spring semester. Accepted students should take NRS 211 online through UWEC during that semester they are waiting to start the nursing courses.

Admission Requirements

In order to be considered for admission to the nursing program, applicants must:

- be accepted as a student to UW-Eau Claire in good standing.
- complete at least 30 transferable semester credits during the semester in which the student is applying, with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.0.
- complete at least 3 of the 5 required sciences by the end of the semester in which the student is applying. At least 2 of these 3 sciences need to be laboratory sciences. All 5 required sciences must be completed **prior** to the start of the semester the student starts the nursing courses, with the exception of biochemistry. Biochemistry can be taken concurrently with the first semester of nursing courses. Science GPA must be a minimum of 2.5.
- earn at least a "C" in all pre-nursing courses (chemistry, biochemistry, anatomy, physiology, microbiology, statistics, developmental psychology, and the wellness courses).
- complete all UWEC nursing program application materials.

Other data that may be used by the Admissions Committee are derived from a variety of sources that include UWEC and nursing program admissions applications, high school transcript showing rank in class, previous college records, and standardized test scores such as the ACT or SAT.

CNA, CPR, Health Records and Background Check

1. Evidence of certification as a nursing assistant (CNA) must be submitted prior to registering for NRS 240.
2. Evidence of CPR certification at the Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescue level, and all required health information must be submitted with nursing program acceptance notification.
3. Evidence of agreement to a criminal background check must be submitted with nursing program acceptance notification.
