

Clean Wisconsin Student Intern Grassroots Organizer – Eau Claire Position Description

Clean Wisconsin is seeking two energetic, self-starting students to conduct grassroots organizing activities in Eau Claire as part of local and statewide environmental policy campaigns. Clean Wisconsin, founded in 1970 as Wisconsin's Environmental Decade, is a leading statewide environmental advocacy organization with 14 full time lobbyists, attorneys, organizers, communication and support staff based in Madison. Interns will be paid \$8.75 an hour for 10 hours per week beginning this June. Work will be conducted in and around Eau Claire with very limited travel to Madison.

The Intern grassroots organizers will participate in:

- Research and environmental policy analysis;
- Making presentations to organizations;
- Organize and facilitate town meetings;
- Organize and participate in media events, conduct other media outreach;
- Organize and supervise phone banks and letter writing campaigns;
- Participate in lobby days in the Capitol

Qualifications include:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
- Ability to work with diverse stakeholder constituencies;
- Strong commitment to environmental protection and public health policies;
- Course work, experience or other demonstrated interest in conservation, natural resource, political science, public health, biology or other related fields;
- Must be highly motivated self starter with strong sense of responsibility
