

Water Quality Section Manager

The Water Quality Section Manager reports to the Office of Drinking Water's Headquarters Deputy Director and is independently responsible for managing the Water Quality Section. The position develops policy, makes decisions, and ensures implementation in numerous areas including Source Monitoring, Surface Water Treatment, Groundwater Under the Direct Influence of Surface Water, Lead and Copper Rule, Cross Connection Control, and laboratory accreditation.

The Water Quality Section consists of 14 staff. The manager directly supervises six technical staff and one unit supervisor who leads the remaining employees.

The funding sources for the Water Quality Section is a combination of local, state, and federal monies. The Water Quality manager has direct budgetary oversight of the section's budget in the amount of \$1,019,00 annually (\$824,000 associated with staff costs and \$195,000 associated with contract costs).
