

Fall Election – Nov. 2, 2010

Every vote counts. Are you ready?

You can check online to see if you are registered. Go to <http://vpa.wi.gov>. Enter your name and date of birth.

If you are not registered to vote in Eau Claire, you have two options.

1. You can register ahead of time at City Hall, 203 S Farwell Street. (That is across the street from the Civic Center and downtown parking ramp.) Register anytime Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. from now until Nov. 1.
2. On Election Day, November 2, you can register at your voting site. Students who live in the dorms on-campus vote at Davies Center. Off-campus students can find their voting site by going online to <http://vpa.wi.gov>.

Everyone registering, either at City Hall or on Election Day, needs to show proof of residence.

On-campus students can show their university ID. We will verify that against the certified student directory we have.

Off-campus students must provide one document showing both their name and their *current* address. This is known as proof of residence.

State-approved forms of proof of residence include:

- Wisconsin driver's license or DOT-issued ID card.
- Gas, electric, cable, refuse, telephone or cell phone bill.
- Bank statement.
- Paycheck.
- Residential lease.

If a person does not have one of the required documents, he or she can use a corroborator or witness. The person acting as the witness must show the required proof of residence.
