Criminal Justice, Comprehensive Major, B.A.

The following is a hypothetical schedule for a Bachelor of Arts degree for Criminal Justice. It is based on the 2014-2015 Catalog. It assumes no transferred credits, no requirements waived by placement tests, and no courses taken in the summer. The Criminal Justice program cannot guarantee that all courses will be offered as shown, but it will provide a range of courses that will enable prepared students to fulfill their requirements in a four-year period. If a particular class on your proposed plan is not available when you register, simply replace it with one of the other required classes. The key is knowing the requirements and being flexible. Regularly consult with your advisor to make sure you are on track to graduate in 4 years. (courses in parentheses are suggested options)
