Modern Japanese Grammar: A Practical Guide is a reference guide providing an overview of the Japanese grammar and functions. It can be used alongside a Japanese language textbook or as a self-study manual. With a strong emphasis on contemporary usage, all items are illustrated with examples written in Romanization and the Japanese script (a mixture of hiragana, katakana, and kanji – Chinese characters). The meanings of example sentences are given in English, facilitating comprehension of unfamiliar words. This volume is divided into two parts, Part A: Structures and Part B: Functions, and has a companion volume *Modern Japanese Grammar: Workbook*.
