



2019-2020 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR Continuing Students

Application deadline is February 1 (to be considered for early awards) or April 1

Information about UWEC-BC Foundation Scholarships

Recipients are selected by the UW-Eau Claire — Barron County Scholarship Committee. Half of the total scholarship award amount is paid at the beginning of each semester (fall and spring) in the academic year. Amounts and availability are subject to change. Unless otherwise specified, all require enrollment as a full-time student.

Please note that “financial need” is determined by EFC score on FAFSA. If FAFSA is not completed, please submit a statement of financial need along with essay.

Sam and Rose Parker Scholarships | Two \$1,250 awards

Continuing student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and who is active on campus and/or in the local community.

Charlie & Juanita Peterson InFaith Community Foundation Scholarship | Two \$1,000 awards

Continuing student who will have completed at least 24 credits by the end of the current academic year, is in good academic standing, and demonstrates financial need.

Fortnightly Club-Beulah Haugen Scholarship | One \$1,000 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 24 credits by the end of the current academic year. Evidence of high academic achievement.

Donald and Joann Clemens Scholarship | One \$1000 award

Continuing student pursuing any field of study who has completed at least 12 credits in good academic standing. Evidence of financial need is a primary criteria.

Francis and Barbara Stauner Family Scholarship | One \$1,000 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year, demonstrates dedication and determination to succeed. Financial need is also a criteria.

Don Henrich & Bruce Gabriel Memorial Scholarship | One \$1,000 award

Full-time first-year or continuing student who is active in the community and/or school activities and demonstrates financial need. 3.0+ GPA is desired, but can be overlooked if effort is evident and other criteria are met.

Rice Lake Area Men’s Club Scholarships | One \$1000 award (Reserved for residents of Rice Lake and Cameron)

Continuing student who will have completed at least 24 credits by the end of the current academic year. Evidence of financial need.

UW-Barron County Foundation Emeritus Board Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year, is in good academic standing, and demonstrates financial need.

UW-Barron County Foundation Board Scholarship | Three \$500 awards

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year, is in good academic standing, and demonstrates financial need.

John “Blackie” & Dolores O’Brien Memorial Scholarship | Two \$500 Awards *one to a male, one to a female*

Full-time first-year or continuing student who has participated in athletics or extra-curricular activities and is pursuing a degree in English, Physical Education or Education. Cumulative GPA of 2.5+; demonstrates financial need.

Ryan Hoeft Memorial Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing full-time student in good academic standing who is pursuing a degree with a criminal justice focus (Criminal Justice, Sociology, Behavioral Science, Law or similar fields).

Dean Yohnk First-Generation Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing first-generation college student (no parent has completed a college degree), who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25, and demonstrates financial need.

James Ellison Memorial Scholarship | One \$500 award (Preference to Biology, Mortuary Science or other Science majors)

A continuing student who has earned a minimum of 12 semester credits and is in good academic standing.

Terry Wiesner Distinguished Alumni Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student who has earned a minimum of 12 credits and is in good academic standing. Involvement in campus or community activities preferred.

Rice Lake Golden K Kiwanis Scholarship | One \$500 award

Student who has completed a minimum of 12 credits, demonstrates dedication, determination and ability to succeed. Financial need is also a criteria.

Rice Lake Lions Club Scholarship | Two \$500 awards

Continuing student who is a Rice Lake High School graduate and has completed at least 12 credits with good academic standing and demonstrates financial need.

Barron County Sunrise Rotary/Service Above Self Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year and is in good academic standing. Preference given to a student from Barron County involved in service-oriented activities.

UWEC-BC Faculty Humanities & Social Science Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.

UWEC-BC Faculty Diversity Scholarship | One \$500 award

Full-time new or continuing student. In your essay, please explain how you will enhance the campus' diversity. Financial need will be taken into consideration when awarding this scholarship.

Kasper Family Political Science & Law Scholarship | One \$350 award

First-year or continuing student currently enrolled in or having successfully completed at least one political science course with plans to pursue a bachelor's degree in Political Science, Legal Studies, Pre-Law, or Criminal Justice within the UW System. Academic success will be considered.

Cumberland Federal Bank Scholarship | One \$250 award

Continuing student from the Cumberland area in good academic standing.

MILITARY VETERANS' SCHOLARSHIPS

Bill Appleyard Memorial Scholarship | One \$250 award

Full-time first-year or continuing student who is active or former military or the dependent of an active or former military member.

BUSINESS RELATED

Marsh Insurance Services Scholarship | One \$600 award

Continuing full-time student with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Evidence of community service involvement and definite financial need. Preference will be given to Rice Lake residents. Any major or undeclared students are eligible but some preference is given to business-related majors.

Paul Durand Scholarship | One \$400 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 24 credits by the end of the current academic year with a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA. Accounting major.

SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

Karl and Judith Schmid Scholarship | One \$800 award

Student majoring in mathematics, natural science, or engineering (with preference given to mathematics). Must have completed beginning calculus course (MAT 221 or equivalent) with a minimum grade of B- or have completed the Advanced Placement Calculus AB exam with a minimum score of 3.

James Stauffer/Kiwanis Club Scholarship | One \$500 award

Returning year student majoring in a science area who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year with a minimum GPA of 3.00.

OASIS 2000 Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student in good standing who is pursuing science, environmental science, or sustainability.

HEALTH RELATED

Community Health Clinic Scholarship | One \$700 award

Continuing student majoring in a health services area.

Lakeview Medical Center Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student who will have completed at least 12 credits by the end of the current academic year, is in good academic standing, and is pursuing a career in a health related occupation.

FINE ARTS

Frank McGinnis Scholarship | Two \$1000 award

First-year or continuing student majoring in the fine arts (theatre, music, or art) with preference given to art majors.

ArtScape on Main Scholarship | One \$500 award

Continuing student pursuing art as a career or for personal enrichment. Former or current ArtScape on Main contributor is a plus. (Deadline for submission of this scholarship is **February 1**. Attendance at ArtScape on Main unveiling on April 9, 2019 and participating in ArtScape on Main activities is expected of the winner.)

Ed and Marla Thompson Scholarship | One \$500 award

Full-time first-year or continuing student enrolled in at least two performing music classes/ensembles on campus or in the community (include details in essay).

Lou Einum Memorial Scholarship | One \$350 award

Continuing student majoring in one of the Fine Arts (art, music or theatre), who maintains a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipient agrees to participate in at least one Fine Arts activity during the academic year.
