

Scholarships at UWECBC



Timeline: After being admitted, eligible students are encouraged to fill out the UW-Eau Claire – Barron County Scholarship Application by February 1 (considered for early awards) or April 1 (scholarship deadline) for other awards.

Amounts: Specific scholarship amounts are listed below. Half of the total scholarship amount is distributed at the beginning of the fall semester and half in the spring.

■ **Red Cedar Scholarship** | Five \$1,000 awards

Recognizes students who have demonstrated academic strength and leadership. Eligible students must have a 25+ ACT score plus top 25% of class (3.5 GPA if class rank is unavailable).

■ **Local UW-Eau Claire – Barron County Scholarship** | Five \$1,000 awards

Incoming first-year students must graduate from one of the high schools listed to the right, which are located within a 40-mile radius of UW-Eau Claire – Barron County. (Home-schooled students who live within a 40-mile radius of campus are eligible to apply). Eligible students must have a 21+ ACT score or be in the top 50% of class (3.0 GPA if class rank is unavailable).

■ **UW-Eau Claire – Barron County Promise** | Five \$1,000 awards

Incoming first-year students who have graduated from a Wisconsin high school and demonstrate financial need.

■ **UWECBC Proud** | Five \$1,000 awards

Incoming first-year students attending UW-Eau Claire or UW-Eau Claire – Barron County who were enrolled in and completed college coursework from UW-Eau Claire – Barron County while in high school with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Eligible students must be in the top 25% of their class (3.5 GPA if class rank is unavailable). Proud to continue the tradition of commitment to education!

UWECBC Foundation Scholarships

Recipients are selected by the UW-Eau Claire – Barron County Scholarship Committee. Half of the total scholarship award amount is paid at the beginning of the fall semester and half in the spring. Amounts and availability are subject to change. Unless otherwise specified, all require enrollment as a full-time student.

PLEASE NOTE that “financial need” is determined by EFC score on the FAFSA. If the FAFSA is not completed, please submit a statement of financial need along with essay.

■ **Rice Lake Rotary Club Scholarship** | One \$1,000 award
Reserved for students from Rice Lake and surrounding communities

■ **Gladys Miller Scholarship** | One \$1,000 award

■ **Katherine (Chick) Stauffer Scholarship** |

One \$500 award

Preference to science, math or social science majors

Ranked in top 33% of class or 3.3 minimum cumulative GPA. Must show solid academic preparation and have participated in extracurricular/leadership activities.

■ **Don Henrich & Bruce Gabriel Memorial Scholarship** | One \$1,000 award

Full-time first-year or continuing student who is active in the community and/or school activities and demonstrates financial need. Ranked in top 50% or 3.0+ GPA is desired, but can be overlooked if effort is evident and other criteria are met.

■ **Frank McGinnis Scholarship** | Two \$1,000 awards

First-year or continuing student majoring in the fine arts (theatre, music, or art) with preference given to art majors.

■ **Karl and Judith Schmid Scholarship** | One \$800 award

First-year or continuing student majoring in mathematics, natural science, or engineering (with preference given to mathematics). Must have completed beginning calculus course (MAT 221 or equivalent) with a minimum grade of B- or have completed the Advanced Placement Calculus exam with a minimum score of 3.

■ **John “Blackie” & Dolores O’Brien Memorial Scholarship** | Two \$500 awards

one to a male, one to a female

First-year or continuing student who has participated in athletics or extra-curricular activities and is pursuing a degree in English, Physical Education or Education. Ranked in top 60% or cumulative GPA of 2.5+; demonstrates financial need.

■ **Johnson Bank Scholarship** | One \$500 award

Incoming student from NW Wisconsin who demonstrates school or community leadership and dedication to succeed.

■ **Community Partnership Scholarships** |

Two \$500 awards

Incoming students with preference to those with a strong history of community involvement.

■ **UW-Barron County Faculty Diversity Scholarship** | One \$500 award

Full-time first-year or continuing student. In your essay, please explain how you will enhance campus diversity. Financial need will be taken into consideration.

■ **Kasper Family Political Science & Law Scholarship** | One \$350 award

First-year or continuing student currently enrolled in or having successfully completed at least one political science course with plans to pursue a bachelor’s degree in Political Science, Legal Studies, Pre-Law, or Criminal Justice within the UW System. Academic success will be considered.

■ **Arnold “Skip” Widdes Scholarship** | One \$250 award

Incoming student demonstrating financial need.

■ **Bill Appleyard Memorial Scholarship** |

One \$250 award

First-year or continuing student who is active or former military or the dependent of an active or former military member.
