Most 700-level courses and 811/813/815/817 meet face-to-face format (and may be online enhanced), generally on a weekly/block scheduled basis. The other 800-level courses are hybrid courses involving on-campus immersion days and online. 1st year courses meet on Mondays, 2nd year courses on Tuesdays, 3rd year courses on Wednesdays.

800-level courses in italics are the 800 courses taken by the MSN to DNP, BSN to DNP take all 800 level courses. All 800 level courses have an additional per credit course fee.

Students in the BSN to DNP select a population focus (Adult-Gerontological or Family Health) and a role preparation (Administration/Nurse Executive, Clinical Nurse Specialist, or Nurse Practitioner). Note: this program prepares graduates for the certification as an AGPCNP or FNP

ACP = Advanced Clinical Practice (Clinical Nurse Specialist or Nurse Practitioner).

Admin = Administration/Nurse executive Administration students required to complete at least 6 credits of cognates.

Administration role courses are offered on alternate years. Begin series on odd years (ie. 2019, 2021)

ACP requires a minimum of 73 credits, and Admin requires a minimum of 68 credits

1 clinical credit = 75 hours. Example: [6(4,2) credits] = 6 credit course with 4 credits lecture/seminar/discussion and 2 credits clinical, requiring a minimum of 150 hours of clinical.

BSN-to-DNP Program can be completed on a Part-Time (4 or 5 year) Basis.

Clinical Hours: Admin = at least 68 credits (includes 6 credits of cognates). Clinical = 14 credits = 1050 hours. Advanced Clinical Practice (ACP) = 73 credits. Clinical = 14.5 credits (includes 704/708) = 1087.5 hours.(750 hours NP primary care preparation)
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
